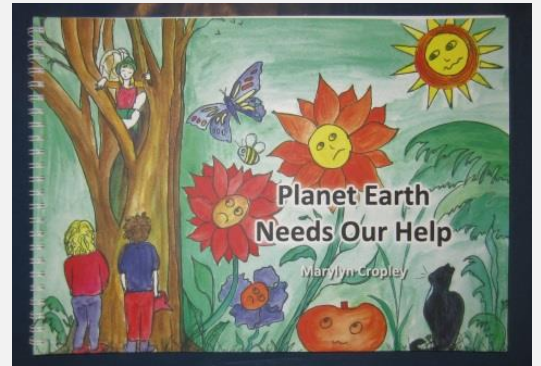
1 st August	12 – 2 pm	Launch Party Dr Martin Price (environmentalist) to open exhib

Written and illustrated by Marylyn Cropley (a member of PEDAS), it celebrates the wonders of our planet and raises awareness of the issues around climate change in a non-threatening, simple, and informative way. We offer visitors to the Dolphin Centre (young and old) an opportunity to:



- Pop in and view the book, speak to the author and have an informal chat with Dr Martin Price (Environmentalist) with any questions or concerns you may have about climate change and its impact on the well-being of our planet and its inhabitants.
- Help create a communal planet earth book of short stories/poems/illustrations inspired by planet earth, with helpful ideas on how we can work together to improve our own well-being and that of the world we live in. There is no planet B!

He plans to have a dais to raise the model, and to use a studio easel with large board to make a big statement!
